## Purpose:

Located at the Recreation Center. Serving children from Kirkwood & Borlaug.

## After School:

- Children are met at Kirkwood Elementary and walked over to the Recreation Center. Children are transported from Borlaug by the City of Coralville van.

- Supervised free play activities
