BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

Purpose:

While providing quality before and after school care is the primary purpose of the program, a secondary mission will be the education of the children about the importance of leisure and recreation. Children will have the opportunity to try many recreational activities, as well as to help in the planning of the activities that their peers will participate in. Through this process, children will build self-esteem and life planning skills, which will benefit their growth.

Before and After School Program:

Children have the option to choose a variety of recreational games, arts and crafts, homework time, recess at the park, and much more during the program. A light breakfast & afternoon snack is served daily.

No School Days:

Van Allen BASP participants will have the opportunity to sign up for childcare for planned non-school days including conference days, spring break, and a portion of winter break. For a list of scheduled No School Days available, please request a copy of the Van Allen BASP Parent Manual.

Weather:

In the event of a school cancellation for blizzard, inclement weather, etc... the program will not be held. If due to heat, the after school program will be held!

Daily Schedule

Before School

- Breakfast is available from 7:00-7:30 a.m.
- Supervised free play activities
- Children are assisted to their class line-up area

After School:

- Free play & snack time in the cafeteria
- Homework & Reading time
- Crafts and "Activity of the Day"
- Recreational games in the gym
- Playground time

After School: 2:55 p.m. – 5:45 p.m.
Thursday Afternoons: 1:55 – 5:45 p.m.
No School Days: 7:00 a.m. – 5:45 p.m.

After School: \$195/month
Both: \$230/month
No School Days: \$40-\$50 per day

Enrollment:

Van Allen BASP has a waiting list as the demand for before and after school program is great.
