How to Participate

1. Gather luminaria supplies.
2. Place sacks, each with a candle and weighted with sand in the bottom, along your sidewalks.
3. Light your candles on Sunday, December 8, 2019, from 5:00-9:00 pm.
4. Enjoy! Please clean up luminarias on your sidewalks by 9:00 am on Monday.
